

HELP IN GETTING YOUR TEXTBOOKS



1. You should verify you have the right book by looking at multiple info items. So, check the title, author, and edition number and always check the ISBN. That's the long string of digits at the end of each entry on the booklist.

2. Booklists can change each quarter, so buy only what you need one quarter at a time.
3. Ways to buy your books:
 - A Barnes & Noble can order them for you
 - You can buy them used on www.abebooks.com
 - You can rent them instead of buying at www.chegg.com
 - You can see if other students are selling them either at www.craigslist.org (type in 'Galen' under books)
4. The library attempts to hold at least one copy of every textbook in the curriculum so that students are never without access to these important resources. Please ask library staff for help when you need them. To help ensure availability, these textbooks must be used in the library and cannot be checked out. The library may also have older editions that can be checked out shelved in the circulating stacks.
